Rules of Entry:

- Only year-round residents of Maine, age 16 or older, please.
- Outside measurement of frame must be no larger than 36" x 36"
- Artwork over 20" x 26" must use Plexiglas.
- Entries must be framed and wired for hanging. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS OR CENTER HOOKS!
- The following information must be attached to the back of work: (1) name, (2) address, (3) phone, (4) title, (5) awards category, and (6) sale price or "NFS"
- Entry fee(s) (payable to **Topsham Public Library**) and signed TPL Gallery Policy and Waiver are due upon delivery of artwork
- The library cannot broker sales of photographers' work; potential buyers must contact photographers directly.

Friends of the Topsham Public Library will prepare a **catalog** for the exhibit with short (300 words or less) biographies/photographer's statements and contact information, if requested. Business cards are not permitted in the exhibit.

Sale prices will be listed in the catalog, but not posted with the exhibits.

*** Photographers are encouraged to donate 10% of the proceeds of sales of Joy of the Lens work to the Topsham Public Library. ***
